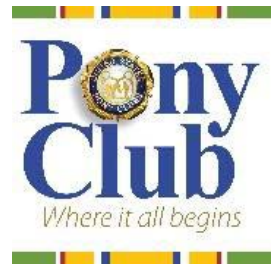

Fun Frolic Series Awards Rules

Champion and Reserve Champion awards will be determined at the end of the Fall Frolic. Awards will be given in Combined Training, Jumpers, and Dressage.

Combined Tests and Jumper Divisions:

Series Awards will be given in the following CT Divisions:

Tadpole, Cross Rails, Green, Advanced Green, Beginner Novice, Novice, Training, Prelim

Series Awards will be given in the following Jumper Divisions:

Tadpole, Cross Rails, Green, Advanced Green, Beginner Novice, Novice, Training, Prelim

Points will be given to the rider/horse combination. Points from all shows will be totaled to determine the champion and reserve champion. In order to qualify for Series awards, the horse/rider combination must compete in the division in at least 2 of the 3 shows in the series.

Points will be awarded as follows:

- 1st place - 6
- 2nd place - 5
- 3rd place - 4
- 4th place - 3
- 5th place - 2
- 6th place - 1

Dressage:

Series Awards will be given in the following Dressage Divisions:

Intro, Training, First, Second

Western: Basic, Intro, Level 1, Level 2, Level 3

The average of the highest 3 scores obtained in the division will be used to determine awards. One of those tests must be the highest test of that level. Scores will be given to the rider/horse combination. In order to qualify for Series awards, the horse/rider combination must compete in the division in at least 2 of the 3 shows in the series.
