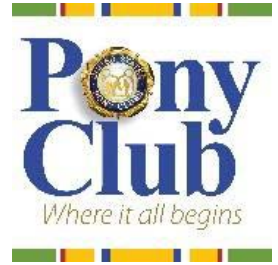

Tadpoles 2019 USDF Intro Test A; Poles on the ground. *Coach is allowed in ring.*

Cross Rails: 2019 USDF Intro Test A; Jumps 18" max

Green: 2019 USDF Intro Test C; Jumps 2' max (no oxers or combinations)

Adv Green: 2018 USEF Beginner Novice Test A; Jumps 2'3" max

Beg. Novice: 2018 USEF Beginner Novice Test A; Jumps 2'7" max

Novice: 2018 USEF Novice Test A; Jumps 2'11" max

Training: 2018 USEF Training Test A; Jumps 3'3" max

Preliminary: 2018 USEF Preliminary Test A; Jumps 3'7" max

Leadline: Let your littlest barn kid ride too – Walk, optional Trot (rail class, ribbons for all)

Fees:

Dressage Tests	\$30 for 1 st test \$25 for additional test(s)
Combined Tests	\$40 per test
Jumper Division	\$25 includes 2 courses + jump-off
Cross Country Clinic	\$60 per horse/rider
Schooling Jumper Round	\$10 per round - choose course A or course B!
Leadline	\$5 per rider
Stabling	\$20 per stall

Division Information:

Jumper Division consists of overall combined score for: Course A, judged by faults and closest to optimum time; Course B, judged by faults and fastest speed, and will include a jump-off for clear rounds.

All Combined Tests will use Course A and standard eventing scoring.

New Tadpole Division! Jump courses consist of poles on the ground. Coach may be in the ring with the rider for both jumping and dressage, and may provide any assistance needed.

Schooling rounds - Choose either course A or course B. If you are competing in a CT or jumper division, then schooling rounds may only be done after your competition round. Schooling rounds may also be added on show day, just come to the show office to pay for additional rounds.

Other information: (PLEASE READ!!)

Late entries MAY be accepted and a \$10 late fee charged, at the Show Secretary's discretion. Ride times will be emailed to competitors on the Thursday before the show, and will be posted on www.RoanokeValleyPonyClub.org. Scratches prior to closing date will receive a full refund less a \$10 office fee. After closing date, NO refunds will be given. All dogs MUST be leashed. Dress is casual, but neat and tidy. Half chaps are allowed. Body protective vests are highly recommended for cross country. ASTM-approved helmets *and medical armbands or medical ID bracelets* must be worn when jumping.

Ribbons to 6th place for each division. Show management reserves the right to combine, divide, or cancel classes as entries warrant.

Concessions will be available on show grounds.

You are welcome to bring non-competing horses for a \$10 grounds fee, and proof of negative Coggins.

Attention XC Schoolers: If you wish to school XC but do not wish to participate in our clinic, you must pay a fee of \$10. For safety, please go with at least one other person or bring a ground person, and check in with the secretary before going on course and after you return.

* Make checks payable to RVPC and mail with completed entry and signed release (page 4) and current (within 12 months of show date) negative Coggins to show secretary at address listed above. Or use electronic entry form and a PayPal invoice will be emailed to you. **Entries, including payment, must be RECEIVED on the closing date or before to be considered on time.**
